ANNUAL REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum points from designated categories 20points and a total of 30 points annually.
- To be rated as a Hospital Food Services Supervisor one needs to be practising in the relevant area of specialisation and also registered as such.
- Each activity, event point can be entered only one and into one category.
